**AMENDED JOINT PETITION OF AT&T FLORIDA AND  
ITS TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. TO TRANSFER TERRITORIES  
IN MARTIN COUNTY AND TO AMEND CERTIFICATES**

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida (“AT&T Florida”) and ITS Telecommunications Systems, Inc. (“ITS”) pursuant to Rules 25-4.005 and 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, jointly petition the Florida Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to modify certain exchange boundaries in Martin County and to amend the companies’ certificates accordingly. In support of this *Amended* Petition, AT&T Florida and ITS state as follows:

1. AT&T Florida is an incumbent local exchange company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. AT&T Florida provides service in Florida under Commission Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 8.

2. ITS is an incumbent local exchange company lawfully doing business in the State of Florida, the regulated operations of which are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission pursuant to Chapter 364, Florida Statutes. ITS provides service in Florida under Commission Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 30.

3. AT&T Florida’s principal place of business in Florida is 675 W. Peachtree St., NE, Suite 4500, Atlanta, GA 30375.

4. ITS’ principal place of business in Florida is 15925 SW Warfield

Boulevard, Indiantown, FL 34956.

6. AT&T Florida and ITS seek to amend the Stuart exchange boundaries in this *Amended* Petition. The boundary change is to transfer a portion of the Sunlight Ranch development (“development”) from the ITS Indiantown Exchange to the AT&T Florida Stuart Exchange. The territory to be transferred consists of approximately six single family lots located in the Northwest corner of the development. No subscribers reside in the area to be transferred; therefore, no subscriber would be affected by modifying the Stuart exchange to include this portion of the development. A copy of a map showing the area to be transferred is attached as Exhibit “A.”

7. The present boundary line bisects the planned subdivision and individual lots, rendering provision of service difficult. The proposed boundary change will better align the companies’ exchange service areas, and will move the existing boundary to

more readily discernible terrain features. This application is sought to permit revisions to company boundaries so that they will not divide subdivisions and lots, thereby rendering the boundaries more usable in the provision and administration of service. Existing telephone service, local service rates, calling areas and calling plans will not be affected by these proposed changes since there are no existing customers in the area to be transferred. Once the transfer is complete, telephone service, local service rates, calling areas and calling plans in the transferred area will be governed by AT&T Florida's General Subscriber Services Tariff.

8. There are no pending applications for basic local service held by AT&T Florida or ITS related to the territory to be transferred.

9. AT&T Florida and ITS do not currently hold any deposits or deposit interest as there are no subscribers in the area to be transferred.

10. No financial exchange or consideration was, or shall be, given for this proposed transfer of certificated areas. This Joint Petition is the only written agreement between ITS and AT&T Florida regarding the transfer of certificated areas.


11. Both AT&T Florida and ITS have agreed that the requested transfer of service area is feasible from an economic standpoint and beneficial to the subscribers of both companies.

12. Pursuant to Rule 25-4.005, Florida Administrative Code, the required affidavit is attached to this Joint Petition as Exhibit "B". The affidavit certifies that notice of intention to file the Petition has been given to those parties set forth in the above cited rule.

13. Upon the Commission's approval of the modifications proposed herein, the companies' will file the final tariff sheets for administrative approval.

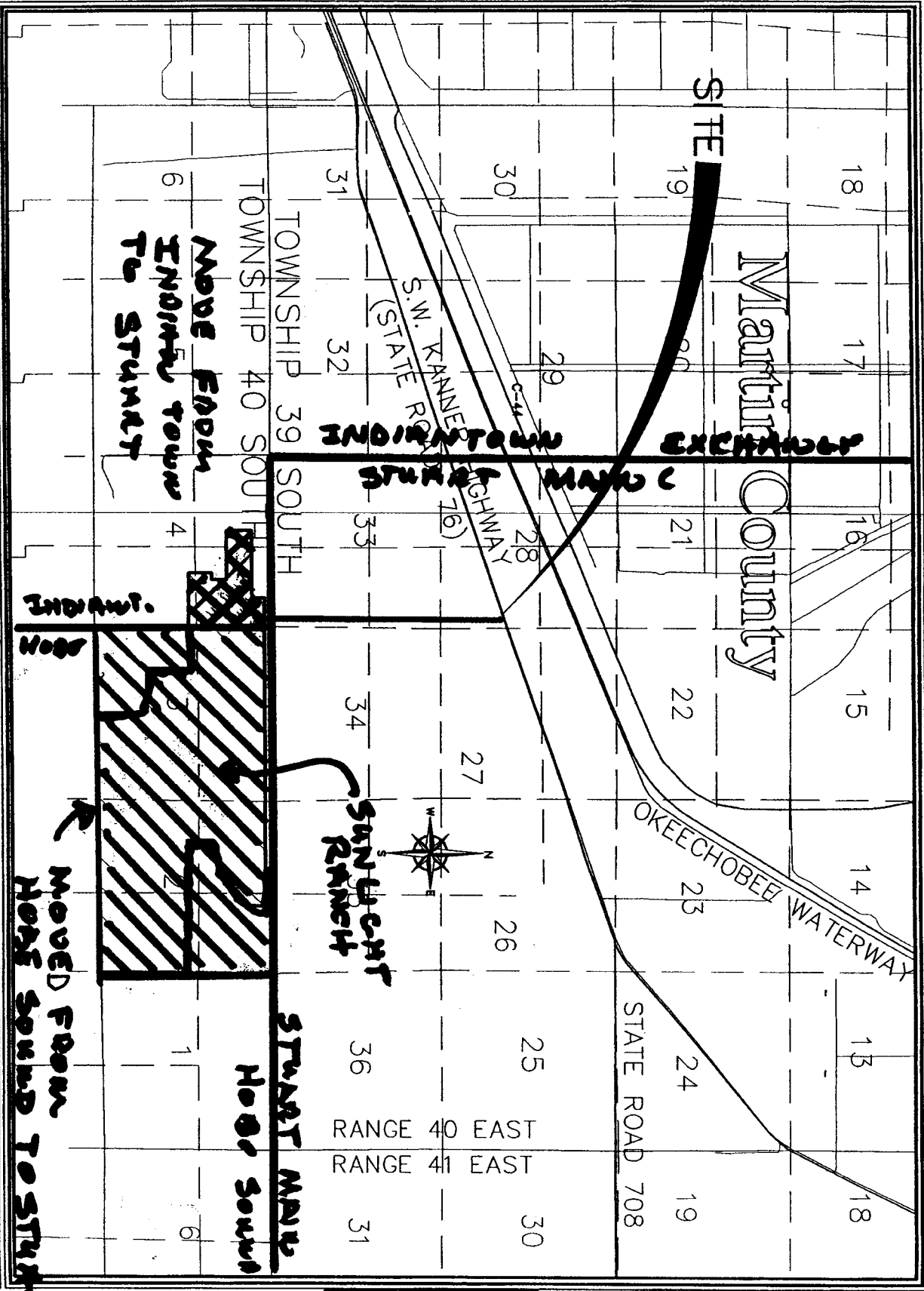
