AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT (the "Amendment") is made, entered into, and effective this 9th day of January 2008, by and between Sprint Spectrum L.P., a Delaware limited partnership, and as agent for SprintCom, Inc., a Kansas corporation, all foregoing entities jointly d/b/a Sprint PCS, with offices at 6200 Sprint Parkway, and GTC, Inc. d/b/a GT Com.
