RE: Recommendation to Office of the General Counsel - Docket No. 080094-TL – Petition for expedited review of NXX-X code denial by Number Pooling Administrator for Clermont exchange by Embarq.

On February 8, 2008, Embarq Florida, Inc., (Embarq) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (NeuStar) for the Clermont exchange, (CLMTFLXADS0) switch. Embarq requested 20 new consecutive DID numbers to specifically meet the request of a customer, and these numbers cannot be in thousand blocks beginning with the digits 0, 1 and 9. On February 8, 2008, Embarq's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the months-to-exhaust and utilization criteria.

On February 13, 2008, Embarq filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NeuStar's decision. In accordance with Commission Order No. PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL, (Docket No. 020087-TL) which approved an expedited process for the NeuStar code denials, staff has examined the Embarq petition and has determined the following:

- 1) The carrier has demonstrated that it has a customer in need of numbering resources;
- 2) The carrier has shown that it is unable to provide services to this potential customer because of NeuStar's denial of the numbering resources; and
- 3) The customer will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of PSC-02-0352-PAA-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (March 4, 2008), as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NeuStar should be directed to provide Embarq the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Clermont exchange, (CLMTFLXADS0) switch. Please allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued. If you have any questions, please call Jim Polk at (850) 413-6510.
