Dear Ms. Cole:

The total amount of money calculated to be refunded was \$39,881.48. The amount was computed as follows, for the first period we calculated the amount billed for the period 11/15/03-8/4/04 and multiplied that amount by 20.79%. For the second period we calculated the amount billed for the period of 8/5/04-12/31/04 and multiplied that amount by 1.03%. We then calculated the interest multiplier and added it to the amount that should be refunded.

The above amounts were refunded by issuing checks or issuing credits on the bills that were all sent out on the 30<sup>th</sup> of October 2007. For the first period we issued credits in the amount of \$28,208.83 and issued refund checks for \$10,679.67. For the second period we issued credits in the amount of \$767.72 and issued refund checks for \$225.26.

As of March 17, 2008 the total amount of unclaimed refunds is \$2449.84.

We are currently investigating the returned refund checks and are resending the ones that have had forwarding addresses applied to the envelopes. At the present time we have not treated any unclaimed refunds as contributions in aid of construction, since we are still seeking to make the refunds.
