On March 31, 2008, Verizon Florida LLC filed a motion asking to hold in abeyance the Petition for Arbitration filed by Intrado Communications Inc. on March 5, 2008. The parties have agreed to stay the arbitration for 60 days to allow for further negotiations, with the objective of eliminating some issues from the arbitration and more clearly defining the ones that remain. In view of the parties’ agreement to continue negotiations, Verizon withdraws its motion for abeyance, conditioned upon the Commission’s accepting the parties’ agreement to defer the arbitration 60 days.
