Issue 3: Should the Commission make any corrections to the reserve allocations between accounts? **Recommendation:** Yes. Staff recommends the reserve allocations shown on Attachment A of staff's memorandum dated March 27, 2008. These allocations bring each account more in line with its theoretically correct reserve level.

<u>Issue 4</u>: What are the appropriate remaining lives, net salvage, reserve amounts, and resultant depreciation rates for SJNG?

Recommendation: The staff's recommended remaining lives, net salvage values, reserves, and resultant depreciation rates are shown on Attachment B of staff's memorandum dated March 27, 2008. The rates, based upon actual investments as of December 31, 2007, would result in an increase in the annual depreciation expense of approximately \$3,989 as summarized on Attachment C of staff's memorandum dated March 27, 2008.
