

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J. Christopher Dixon, President & COO



Mr. Dixon has been engaged in telecommunications and financial management for more than 18 years. He is currently the CEO and President of OneTone Telecom, Inc. Prior to joining OneTone Telecom he served as Vice President of Planning and Corporate Development and Strategy for Actel Integrated Communications. In this capacity he was responsible for development of the business plan that received \$75 million in funding, as well as additional responsibilities that included product development and pricing, which included developing the suite of products to be offered, performing pricing feasibility analyses, and determining margin analysis based on costing studies.
