In addition to administrative expenses allowed by the Court, **priority claims totaling \$7,362.19** must be paid in advance of any dividend to general unsecured creditors. The priority dividend is anticipated to be 100.000000% of the gross estate.

Claims of **general unsecured creditors totaling \$15,564,773.53** have been allowed and will be paid, pro rata, only after all allowed administrative and priority claims have been paid in full. The proposed general unsecured dividend is 0.163418%, but may vary if the amounts allowed for administrative expenses vary from the applications set forth above.


