

**AQUA UTILITIES FLORIDA, INC.'S MOTION FOR LEAVE
TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL DIRECT TESTIMONY
TO ADDRESS ISSUES RAISED AT CUSTOMER SERVICE HEARINGS**

Aqua Utilities Florida, Inc. ("AUF"), by and through its undersigned counsel, respectfully requests leave to file supplemental direct testimony on August 29, 2008, after the final service hearing to address issues raised during the course of the customer service hearings held in this proceeding. In support of its motion, AUF states:

1. During the customer service hearings in this proceeding, customer testimony has been given concerning quality of service, customer service, and billing issues. In order to fully inform the Commission and the parties on issues related thereto, and in the interest of fairness, testimony in response to these issues is in order.

2. Allowing AUF the opportunity to accelerate its response to issues addressed at the customer service hearings with testimony is consistent with the precedent and procedures established in the last rate case involving AUF in Docket No. 060368-WS.

3. Allowing AUF to file supplemental direct testimony limited to the topics raised at the customer service hearings would better inform the Commission and the parties of AUF's actions related to the issues addressed at the customer service hearings, the results of alleged billing issues raised, and its effort to address the quality of service issues raised.

4. The filing of supplemental direct testimony will not prejudice any of the other parties, and would hopefully be encouraged. The final customer hearing is currently scheduled

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
for August 22, 2008. Allowing supplemental direct testimony to be filed after the August 29, 2008, as opposed to waiting until later in the process, will give the other parties ample opportunity to respond to AUF's supplemental testimony in their direct testimony.

5. AUF has been authorized by counsel for OPC to represent that OPC does not object to the granting of this motion.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, AUF respectfully requests that the Prehearing Officer grant this Motion and allow AUF to file, by August 29, 2008, its supplemental direct testimony addressing issues raised during the customer service hearings.


