**AMENDED PETITION**

Florida Public Utilities Company ("FPUC" or the "Company"), by and through its undersigned counsel, herewith files this Amended Petition and as basis states:


1. On August 4, 2008, FPUC filed its Petition for Approval of Fuel Adjustment and Purchased Power Cost Recovery True-Up Amount for FPUC. Accompanying the Petition was testimony and exhibits as required by the Commission.

2. The schedules which were attached as exhibits to the testimony were prepared based on information that the cost for power purchased by the Company in the Northeast Division would reduce in October. That was subsequently revised and the purpose of this Amended Petition is to revise the testimony and schedules to reflect the revised information.

3. In the testimony and schedules filed August 4, 2008, the Company projected an overrecovery at the end of December 2008 for Fernandina Beach of \$26,687 and a true-up amount for January - December 2008 of an underrecovery of \$922,558. The revised and updated calculations and schedules and testimony as relates to Fernandina Beach reflect a projected underrecovery in purchased power costs of \$455,865 at the end of December 2008 and an estimated true-up amount of an underrecovery of \$1,405,110 for January - December 2008. These updated calculations are shown on Schedules E1-A, E-1B, and E1-B1 filed herewith and the revised testimony which is also filed with this Petition.

4. These revisions, which are applicable to Fernandina Beach only, have been used in the projection filings submitted to the Commission September 8, 2008.

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
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
