APPLICATION OF SILVER LAKE UTILITIES, INC., FOR AMENDMENT TO WASTEWATER CERTIFICATE NO. 546-S

SILVER LAKE UTILITIES, INC. (the "Utility" or "Applicant"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to Section 367.045(2), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.036, Florida Administrative Code, files this Application for Amendment to Wastewater Certificate No. 546-S to extend its service area to include certain land (the "Extension Area") in Highlands County, Florida, and in support thereof states:

1. The exact name of the Applicant and the address of its principal business

3. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3), Florida Administrative Code, the

Applicant provides the following information:

DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE 09134 SEP 29 8 FPSC-COMMISSION CLERK (a) The Applicant's complete name and address are as set out above.

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(b) The Applicant has the financial and technical ability to provide wastewater service to the area applied for herein. The Utility has the financial backing to provide adequate and reasonable service to the Extension Area. A related-party developer will be applying for approval of a development of regional impact ("DRI"), as defined under Section 380.06, Florida Statutes, in the Extension Area. The related-party developer has named the Utility as its provider of water and wastewater service. Access to water and wastewater service is a necessary component to the DRI application. The Utility will employ personnel necessary to ensure efficient provision of wastewater service to the various customers of the Utility, and to meet the future and expanding needs anticipated for wastewater service within the proposed territory. Engineering services are being provided by Wilson-Miller. Regulatory financial services are being provided by Cronin, Jackson, Nixon & Wilson. Rose, Sundstrom & Bentley, LLP is providing legal regulatory representation.

Through funding and the financial support of its sole shareholder, the Utility will have ample financial backing to ensure the safe, efficient and sufficient provision of wastewater service to the territory applied for herein and the construction of wastewater facilities as needed in the proposed service area to meet all future needs. At Staff's request, Lykes Bros., Inc., will provide such confidential financial information as may be required to satisfy the Commission that it has ample capital resources to support the funding and financial needs of the Utility and all future needs as they become known. Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a statement from Lykes Bros. Inc., ensuring its financial commitment to the Utility for all future capital requirements and operating losses. The

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Utility has access to all resources needed to fund the capital and long-term financial needs of the Utility.

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(c) To the best of the Applicant's knowledge, the provision by the Applicant of wastewater service to the Extension Area is consistent with the wastewater sections of the Highlands County Comprehensive Plan at the time this Application is filed, as approved by the Department of Community Affairs.

(d) As documentary evidence of the Applicant's continued right to use the land on which its wastewater plant will be constructed, the Utility intends to enter into a long-term lease such as those approved by the Commission for the Utility in Docket No. 060726-WS.

(e) A description of the Extension Area, using township, range and section references, is attached hereto as Exhibit "B". The wastewater territory requested herein is identical to the water territory granted to the Applicant in Commission Order No. PSC-08-0520-FOF-WU, issued August 12, 2008 in Docket No. 080213-WU.

(f) One copy of the detailed wastewater system map showing the proposed lines, and treatment facilities is attached hereto as Exhibit "C".

(g) Final engineering has not been completed with respect to the ultimate design of any wastewater facilities. At present, the design calls for effluent disposal by means of reuse. Reclaimed water produced by the wastewater treatment plant will be pumped to holding ponds prior to it being used to meet irrigation demands in the Extension Area. When appropriate, the Utility will construct wastewater facilities that comply with statutes, rules and regulations pertaining to the disposal of effluent by means of reuse.

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(h) N/A

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(i) Map of the Extension Area showing township, range and section, is attached hereto as Exhibit "D".

(j) The Utility will construct new facilities as needed with sufficient capacity to ensure adequate and reasonable service.

(k) N/A

(1) The Utility plans to arrange for a mix of long-term and short-term debt financing for the construction of wastewater facilities as needed, and to use service availability charges collected from future customers as an offset to that debt. It is anticipated that there will be no material impact on the Utility's capital structure.

(m) This Application is not intended to, nor will it, affect the type or quality of service already provided by the Applicant or the types customers served. The amendment of the Applicant's wastewater certificate for the purposes described in this Application will not interrupt, curtail or otherwise affect the provision of water service to the Applicant's existing customers. The Utility anticipates that it will serve a mix of single family, multi-family, commercial, office, light industrial, hotel and golf courserelated customers in the Extension Area as development progresses.

(n) The amendment of the Applicant's certificated wastewater service territory for the purposes described in this Application will not have any impact on the Applicant's rates or service availability charges.

(o) Attached hereto as Exhibit "E" are the original and two copies of the revised wastewater tariff sheets reflecting the addition of the Extension Area. Copies of the revised tariff sheets are attached to each copy of this Application.

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(p) Original Certificate No. 546-S was granted in Order No. PSC-07-0717-FOF-WS. Separate certificate documents are no longer issued.

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(q) The Applicant's last general rate review was in Docket No. 060726-WS which was its original certification proceeding. That proceeding concluded with Order No. PSC-07-0983-PAA-WS, issued December 10, 2007.

(r) Attached hereto as Exhibit "F" is an Affidavit regarding the current status of the Applicant's current Annual Report and Tariff on file with the PSC.

5. The approval of this Application is in the public interest because there is a need for service in the Extension Area and there is no other utility in the area of the proposed territory willing and capable of providing reasonably adequate service to the Extension Area. It is in the public interest for the Applicant's wastewater certificates to be amended for these purposes.

6. The Applicant will file, as Late Filed Exhibit "G", an Affidavit that notice of the Application was given in accordance with Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, by regular mail to the following:

- (1) the governing body of the municipality, county or counties in which the system or territory proposed to be served is located;
- (2) the privately owned water utility that holds a certificate granted by the Public Service Commission and that is located within the county in which the utility or the territory proposed to be served is located;
- (3) if any portion of the proposed territory is within one mile of a county boundary, the utility shall notice the privately owned utilities located in the bordering counties and holding a certificate granted by the Commission;
- (4) the regional planning council;
- (5) the Office of Public Counsel;

- (6) the Public Service Commission's Director of Records and Reporting;
- (7) the appropriate regional office of the Department of Environmental Protection; and
- (8) the appropriate water management district.

Copies of the Notice and a list of entities noticed accompany the Affidavit.

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7. The Applicant will file, as Late Filed Exhibit "H", an Affidavit that notice of the Application was given in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, by regular mail or personal delivery to each property owner in the Extension Area.

8. The Applicant will file, as Late Filed Exhibit "I", an Affidavit that notice of the Application was published once a week in a newspaper of general circulation in the territory in accordance with Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code.

9. The filing fee required by Rule 25-30.020(2)(b), Florida Administrative Code, is \$2,250.00, because the Extension Area has the proposed capacity to serve more than 4,000 wastewater ERCs. A check in that amount is included with this filing.

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Detailed Wastewater System Map





EXHIBIT "D"


