# APPLICATION OF PLACID LAKES UTILITIES, INC. FOR INCREASED WATER RATES IN HIGHLANDS COUNTY

Placid Lakes Utilities, Inc. ("Placid Lakes"), hereinafter referred to as the "Applicant", pursuant to Section 367.081 (2), (3), (5), (6), (7) and (8), Section 367.0816 and Section 367.082 (1), (2), (3), (4), and (5), Florida Statutes (2008); Rules 25-30.433, 25-30.436, 25-30.437, 25-30.4385, 25-30.440 and 25-30.4415, Florida Administrative Code; and Class B Water and/or Wastewater Utilities Financial, Rate and Engineering Minimum Filing Requirements, Form PSC/ECR 20-W, hereby files its Application for authority to increase water rates and charges and states as follows:

1. The name and principal business address of the Applicant is as follows:

3. Applicant was incorporated on June 11, 1970 under the laws of the State of Florida

and is currently authorized to conduct business in the State of Florida. Applicant is a Class B water utility providing service in Highlands County.

4. This Application is filed pursuant to Section 367.081 (2), (3), (5), (6), (7) and (8), Section 367.816 and Section 367.082(1), (2), (3), (4), and (5), Florida Statutes (2008).

5. Applicant requests that this Application be processed pursuant to the Proposed Agency Action procedure outlined in Section 367.081(8), Florida Statutes (2008).

6. An Affidavit signed by Peggy Ann Brewer, Vice President and Secretary of the Applicant, stating that Applicant will comply with the noticing requirements set forth in Rule 25-22.0407, Florida Administrative Code, for applications for water rate increases, is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

7. The Applicant was last granted rate relief by the Commission pursuant to Order No. PSC-01-0327-PAA-WU issued in Docket No. 00295-WU (full rate proceeding) and Order No. PSC-02-1657-PAA-WU issued in Docket No. 011621-WU (limited proceeding). Except as may be specifically identified herein, Applicant does not know of any manner in which this Application deviates from the policies, procedures or guidelines prescribed by the Commission and relevant rules prescribed by the Commission in Applicant's last rate case.

8. A check in the amount of \$3,500.00 accompanies this Application as the filing fee for the request for increased water rates.

9. The documents in the Minimum Filing Requirements in support of and accompanying this Application are incorporated herein by reference. This Application and supporting documents may be inspected at the Applicant's business office located at 410 Washington Boulevard NW, Lake Placid, Florida 33852.

10. The necessity for a rate increase arises from the fact that Applicant did not earn a fair and reasonable rate of return for the historical test year ended December 31, 2007. For the historical test year ended December 31, 2007, Applicant experienced a negative rate of return of (3.72%). Applicant has used a historical test year ended December 31, 2007 as the basis for requesting interim rates pursuant to Section 367.082, Florida Statutes, and a projected average test year ending December 31, 2008 as the basis for requesting final rates pursuant to Section 367.081, Florida Statutes.

11. The primary reasons for the continued deterioration of returns through the historical test year ended December 31, 2007 are that (i) total operating expenses have increased approximately 50% from the 1999 test year used in the Applicant's last rate case related primarily to increases in health insurance costs, electric utility costs and petroleum costs, (ii) real estate taxes have approximately doubled during said period of time and (iii) approximately \$808,380 of plant additions and improvements have been made during said period of time.

12. Applicant is currently experiencing a severe earnings shortfall. Actual, historical 2007 data has been utilized for purposes of establishing interim rates with projected test year 2008 year end investments reflected in the proposed final rates. Applicant proposes and will establish in this proceeding that a fair and reasonable rate of return on its rate base is 9.45%. This proposed rate of return is based in part on the Commission's approval of a return on equity invested in water operations of 9.53%.

13. Based on the foregoing and in order to have an opportunity to earn a fair and reasonable rate of return on its rate base for water services, the Commission should allow Applicant to place into effect final rates which will produce increased annual operating revenues

for water operations of \$169,182. Such increase would result in total annual water revenues of \$705,582.

14. Pending the establishment of final rates in this proceeding, Applicant requests interim water rates as set forth in its Minimum Filing Requirements. The interim rates are based on the test year ended December 31, 2007 and will produce additional sales revenues for water operations of \$101,903.

WHEREFORE, the Applicant requests:

.

A. That the Commission take jurisdiction over this Application;

B. That the Commission allow Applicant to place into effect interim rates which will produce additional operating revenues in the amount of \$101,903;

C. That the Commission allow Applicant to place into effect final rates which will produce additional operating revenues in the amount of \$169,182;

D. That the Commission find that a fair and reasonable rate of return on Applicant's rate base is 9.45% based on a return on equity of 9.53% for the projected test year ending December 31, 2008; and

E. That the Commission grant any other relief it deems fair, just, equitable and appropriate.
