**NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST
CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Progress Energy Florida, Inc., ("PEF" or "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), submits this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of confidential portions of information attached to PEF's petition referenced above and filed on October 22, 2008.

Specifically, information contained in Exhibits 1 through 4 of PEF's petition to allow transportation fuel surcharge hedging, contain sensitive business information concerning contract information and transportation fuel surcharges, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the Company to negotiate contracts on favorable terms. If contract companies were allowed to compare the transportation fuel surcharges being negotiated, it could lead to adverse effects for the Company, causing an increase in contract rates.


