Dear Mr. Twomey:

This letter is to notify you that Commission staff has reviewed Aqua Utilities Florida Inc.'s (Aqua) applications to amend its water and wastewater certificates in the above referenced dockets. The following is a summary of the status of each application:

Docket No. 080534-WS (Pasco County)

Pasco County's objection with respect to this docket has been withdrawn. The application will be processed as a quick-take amendment. The maps and legal descriptions are complete. It appears that notice needs to be given to property owners in the portion of the proposed extension area that is adjacent to the Jasmine Lakes system.

Docket No. 080535-WU (Palm Beach County)

The application will be processed as a quick-take amendment. Both the amendment and revised maps and legal descriptions need to be corrected. There do not appear to be any property owners adjacent to the Lake Osborne system that need to be noticed.

Docket No. 080536-WU (Brevard County)

The application will be processed as a quick-take amendment. Our review of the information contained in this docket revealed that the amendment, revised map, and legal descriptions need to be corrected. In addition, it appears that notice needs to be given to property owners in the proposed extension area adjacent to the Oakwood system.

Docket No. 080537-WU (Polk County)

The customer's objection filed in this docket appears to have been resolved. The application will be processed as a quick-take amendment. The revised map and legal description for the Lake Gibson system need to reflect a point of beginning that commences from the Northwest corner instead of the Southeast corner.

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of the Northeast corner. I have already made the correction on our copy of the map; please ensure that Aqua's map also reflects this correction. It appears that notice needs to be given to property owners in the proposed extension area adjacent to the Lake Gibson Estates system.

Docket No. 080538-WU (Volusia County)

If Volusia County chooses to pursue an objection, it will need to file a petition to late file its formal objection. The maps and legal description are complete. There do not appear to be any property owners adjacent to the Tomoka system that need to be noticed.

Docket No. 080539-WS (Putnam County)

The amendment and revised maps and legal descriptions for Interlachen Estates/Park Manor need to be corrected. The amendment water maps and legal descriptions for Silver Lake Oaks need to be corrected. It appears that notice needs to be given to property owners in the proposed extension area adjacent to the Palm Port and Interlachen Estates/Park Manor systems.

Docket No. 080540-WS (Lake County)

Mr. Kevin White's objection regarding the amendment to the Haines Creek system appears to have been resolved. The City of Leesburg is considering withdrawing its objection based on proposed revisions to Aqua's amendment application. The amendment and revised water maps and legal descriptions for Silver Lake Estates/Western Shores need to be corrected to reflect the changes agreed upon with the City of Leesburg. It appears that notice needs to be given to property owners in the proposed extension areas adjacent to the East Lake Harris, Friendly Center, Haines Creek, 48 Estates, Kings Cove, Holiday Haven, Morningview, Silver Lake Estates/Western Shores systems.

Docket No. 080541-WU (Marion County)

The amendment map and legal description for Sky Ranch needs to be corrected. It appears that notice needs to be given to property owners in the proposed extension area adjacent to the Sky Ranch and 49<sup>th</sup> Street systems.
