REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION PROVIDED PURSUANT TO STAFF'S FOURTH REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS (NO.12)

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") requests confidential classification of certain documents responsive to Staff's Fourth Request for Production of Documents No.12 (the" Confidential Discovery") which was served by Staff on July 23, 2008. In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

- FPL served its response to Staff's Fourth Request for Production of Documents 1. on August 22, 2008, but did not provide Staff the confidential responsive documents at that time; rather, the confidential documents were available for inspection in FPL's Tallahassee office. Subsequently, Staff requested certain of the confidential documents, which FPL filed with a notice of intent to seek confidential classification on October 31, 2008. Pursuant to Rule 25-22,006(3)(a), FPL has 21 days from the date of the notice of intent to file a formal request for confidential classification. This request is intended to request confidential classification of the confidential documents that were filed with the notice of intent (the "Filed Confidential Documents").
 - 2. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:
- Exhibit A consists of the Filed Confidential documents. All information a. in Exhibit A that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted. Exhibit A is submitted separately in a seal folder marked "CONFIDENTIAL"

- b. Exhibit B consists of an edited version of Exhibit A on which all information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been redacted.
- c. Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A, together with references to the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affidavit in support of the requested classification.
- d. Exhibit D is the affidavit of Kathryn S. Salvador, who is the Project Development Manager in the Project Development and Renewables Department.
- 3. FPL seeks confidential protection for the information highlighted in Exhibit A. The highlighted information is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e) because it contains information concerning bids or other contractual information, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. Similarly, disclosure of the information could impair the competitive business of the counter party of service.
- 4 FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3). Pursuant to Section 366.093, such information is entitled to confidential treatment and it is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law.
- 5. The highlighted information in Exhibit A is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained.
- 6. Upon a finding by the Commission that the information highlighted in Exhibit A, and referenced in Exhibit C, is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to

FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. See § 366.093(4).

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests confidential classification of the Confidential Discovery as described herein.
