| 2 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Let's call the Prehearing |
| 3 | to order. |
| 4 | And, Staff, would you please read the notice. |
| 5 | MS. BROWN: By notice issued December 22nd, 2008, |
| 6 | this time and place was set for a Prehearing Conference in |
| 7 | Docket Number 080614-EM, petition to determine need for |
| 8 | Greenland Energy Center Combined Cycle Conversion in Duval |
| 9 | County by JEA. |
| 10 | The purpose of the Prehearing Conference is set out |
| 11 | in the notice. |
| 12 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Thank you. |
| 13 | And we'll take appearances. Mr. Perko. |
| 14 | MR. PERKO: Good afternoon, Commissioner. My name is |
| 15 | Gary Perko on behalf of JEA. |
| 16 | MS. BROWN: And Martha Carter Brown on behalf of the |
| 17 | Commission. |
| 18 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: I lost you there for a |
| 19 | minute. I was looking. |
| 20 | MS. HELTON: Mary Anne Helton, Advisor to the |
| 21 | Commission. |
| 22 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Thank you. |
| 23 | Okay. Ms. Brown, are there any preliminary matters |
| 24 | we need to address before we get to the draft prehearing order? |
| 25 | MS. BROWN: I'm not aware of any, Commissioner. |

| 10 | MR. PERKO: NO. |
| 11 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. Conduct of |
| 12 | Proceedings? Jurisdiction? |
| 13 | MR. PERKO: NO. |
| 14 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Procedure for Handling |
| 15 | Confidential Information. |
| 16 | Prefiled Testimony and Exhibits; Witnesses. Okay. |
| 17 | Order of Witnesses. |
| 18 | MS. BROWN: Commissioner, staff expects that at least |
| 19 | some of the witnesses in this hearing can be excused if the |
| 20 | Commissioners don't have any questions for them. |
| 21 | The Prehearing Order states that Staff will notify |
| 22 | JEA by February 9th, 2009, if the witnesses have been excused |
| 23 | or if the Commissioners will have questions for them. |
| 24 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. And, of course, at |
| 25 | that time we will find out if Commissioners do have any other |
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| 1 | questions and let the parties know. |
| 2 | Basic Positions. |
| 3 | MR. PERKO: No change. |
| 4 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Issues and Positions. |
| 5 | MS. BROWN: Commissioner, JEA and staff have not had |
| 6 | the opportunity to discuss stipulations to the issues at this |
| 7 | time, but we expect to be having those discussions and we'll |
| 8 | probably have stipulations available before the final |
| 9 | prehearing order is issued, so the final prehearing order would |
| 10 | reflect those. |
| 11 | COMMISSIONER ARGENZIANO: Okay. That sounds great. |
| 12 | I hope there is continued talking on that. That would be |
| 13 | great. |
| 14 | The Exhibit List. |
| 15 | MS. BROWN: To that same end, JEA and staff will |
| 16 | discuss stipulating testimony and exhibits into the record, and |
| 17 | we'll indicate those stipulations in the final prehearing |

| 11 | we're going to keep this in the Prehearing Order for the time |
| 12 | being. |
