Staff respectfully requests approval to make oral modifications to Item 11 scheduled for the agenda this coming Monday, Jan. 26th. Item 11 relates to the PAA recommendation regarding an application for increase in water and wastewater rates in Lake County by Lake Utility Services, Inc. The oral modifications are necessary due to inadvertently double-counting the amount of reuse revenues to be removed from the final wastewater revenue requirement before setting wastewater rates. This had the effect of understating both the appropriate wastewater revenues from rates and the resulting final wastewater rates.

1) Changes to Issue 19, page 32:

** The next to the last sentence of both the recommedation statement and staff's analysis should be changed to read: "The post-repression revenue requirement for the wastewater system is \$1,944,781 \$2,059,326.

2) Changes to Issue 20, page 34:

- ** The second sentence of the recommendation paragraph should be changed to read: "Excluding miscellaneous service revenues, the recommended water rates are designed to produce revenues of \$5,235,010, while the recommended wastewater rates are designed to produce revenues of \$1,944,781 \$2,059,326.
- ** In the first paragraph of staff's analysis, the first sentence should be changed to read: "Excluding miscellaneous service revenues, the recommended water rates are designed to produce revenues of \$5,235,010; the recommended wastewater rates are designed to produce revenues of \$1,944,781 \$2,059,326.
- ** In the first paragraph of staff's analysis, the last sentence should be changed to read: "For the wastewater system, approximately 50 percent (or \$972,391 \$1,029,663) of the monthly service revenues is recovered through the base facility charges, while approximately 50 percent (or \$972;391 \$1,029,663) represents revenue recovery through the consumption charges.
