PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this workshop is to provide a forum for Florida electric utilities and the three major Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers to brief the Commission on their 2009 hurricane season preparation.

The Commission staff requests that each participating utility, carrier, and association representative provide a computerized version of their presentation on CD, such as may be produced using MS PowerPoint, to Patti Zellner in the Office of Strategic Analysis and Governmental Affairs, Public Service Commission, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, no later than April 27, 2009. Each participating utility, carrier, and association should also provide Ms. Zellner with 40 hard copies of their presentations. Sixty hard copies are requested from any utility or association that does not provide computerized presentations. Along with the presentations, please include the name(s) of the presenters, the utility(ies)/carrier(s) represented, and a contact phone number. Copies of the presentations should be provided to Ms. Zellner no later than April 27, 2009.

Each presentation must address the status of preparation each utility or carrier has achieved for protecting its transmission and distribution assets for the 2009 hurricane season. Such preparation may include the status of facility inspections; maintenance and repairs; coordination with other utilities, government, and community groups; various storm hardening measures; post-storm recovery plans; and forensic data collection plans. The presentations should address not only preparations completed, but also work remaining to be completed. Finally, the presentations should address areas of concern or vulnerability.

It is anticipated that each utility, carrier, or association representative will make a 10 to 15 minute presentation before the Commission, immediately followed by a brief question and answer period by the Commissioners and staff. An agenda will be prepared upon receipt of the presentations and subsequently distributed to the participants.
