We appreciate being notified about this meeting. However, we are frustrated that it has been scheduled during the time of year when the majority of Fairmount Utilities, The 2^{nd} , Inc.'s customers have gone north and are unable to attend.

The physical operation at Fairmount Utilities is problematic. Far too often there are disgusting odors coming from the area. Our back yard is just across Georgia Avenue. It was about two years ago that we first noticed the odors from the plant. The odor problem was ongoing when we left Florida on April 20th of this year. There have been numerous phone calls to Mr. Chris Miller. He has never said he will take care of the problem. Instead, he tells me technical details about which I have no interest nor understanding. Employees of the EPA have come to the plant, and commented, "It shouldn't be like this.", yet nothing changes. Also, an employee from the Highlands County Health Department said he would be issuing several citations. Still, nothing has changed.

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Please deny the request for this rate increase. Please force Fairmount Utilities to eliminate the odors coming from the area of their sewer plant. If Fairmount Utilities eliminates the odor problem, residents of Fairmount Mobile Estates would probably support a fair rate increase.



Being residents of Fairmount Mobile Estates, we first of all feel it is most unfair to hold this "customer meeting" in May, knowing full-well that a great majority of the residents of Fairmount Mobile Estates are "snow birds"; and are now in their northern homes. Many of us would like to be at this meeting in person to express some of our concerns with Fairmount Utilities. Therefore, we are requesting this meeting be postponed until such time that the majority of the residents could be there. If this is not possible, we will try to make our concerns heard through this letter.

Over the past several years, it has been one of our major complaints that there is a horrible odor that emanates from Fairmount Utilities treatment plant and retention ponds. We have on numerous occasions contacted Chris Miller to ask if there is something that can be done about the stench. His reply is always some scientific explanation about why he CAN'T fix the odor problem instead of doing something about it.

We have also contacted the DEP (Department of Environmental Protection) and the Health Department. There should be records on file as to these calls. There are many elderly people in our park with breathing problems, and this cannot be a healthy situation. We also have started a petition from the residents of Fairmount Mobile Estates stating that the offensive odors coming from the plant have now become intolerable. We are requesting Fairmount Utilities to do whatever is necessary to totally eliminate the odors. As of this date, we do not have all of the signatures. At this time we have approximately 100 names and feel certain there will be many more to add in the fall. We were blind-sided by this rate hike request.
