NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a prehearing conference will be held at the following time and place:

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The purpose of this prehearing conference is: (1) to define and limit, if possible, the number of issues; (2) to determine the parties' positions on the issues; (3) to determine what facts, if any, may be stipulated; (4) to dispose of any motions or other matters that may be pending; and (5) to consider any other matters that may aid in the disposition of these cases.

## **HEARING**

A hearing will be held before the Florida Public Service Commission in the above dockets regarding the petition of Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) for a rate increase and regarding FPL's 2009 depreciation and dismantlement study, at the following time and place:

Monday, August 24, 2009, 9:30 a.m. Betty Easley Conference Center, Room 148 4075 Esplanade Way Tallahassee, Florida

August 25 - 28 and 31, 2009 and September 2 - 4, 2009, have also been reserved for the continuation of the hearing, if needed. The starting time of the next day's session will be announced at the conclusion of the prior day. The hearing will be adjourned early if all testimony is concluded.

## **PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE**

The purpose of this hearing will be for the Commission to consider FPL's petition for a rate increase, FPL's 2009 depreciation and dismantlement study, and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

This proceeding shall: (1) allow FPL to present evidence and testimony in support of its petition for a rate increase and its 2009 depreciation and dismantlement study; (2) permit any intervenors to present testimony and exhibits concerning these matters; (3) allow for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate.

## **JURISDICTION**

This Commission is vested with jurisdiction over the subject matter by the provisions of Chapter 366, Florida Statutes. This hearing will be governed by said Chapter as well as Chapter 120, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Chapters 25-6, 25-17, 25-22, and 28-106, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

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## APPLICABLE STATUTES AND RULES

Sections 366.04, 366.05, 366.06, F.S., and any other relevant sections of Chapter 366, F.S., are applicable to this proceeding, as well as Chapter 120, F.S., and Chapters 25-6, 25-17, 25-22, and 28-106, F.A.C.

Those wishing to intervene in these proceedings, unless appearing on their own behalf, must be represented by an attorney or other person who can be determined to be a qualified representative pursuant to Chapter 120, F.S., and Rule 28-106.106, F.A.C. Petitions for leave to intervene must be filed at least five (5) days before the final hearing, must conform with Rule 28-106.201(2), F.A.C., and must include allegations sufficient to demonstrate that the intervenor is entitled to participate in the proceeding as a matter of constitutional or statutory right or pursuant to Commission rule, or that the substantial interests of the intervenor are subject to determination or will be affected through the hearing.
