Anna,

I am writing to let you know that FPL performed the computations necessary to determine whether the gantry crane revenue requirement subject to approval in this proceeding is sufficient by itself to change base rates. The answer is no, it is not. Therefore FPL will not be revising its rate case compliance filing to change proposed rates. Of course, the revenue requirement for the gantry crane will be reflected prospectively in FPL's surveillance reporting and in the computation of the next NCRC base rate filing, which is likely to occur late in 2010.
