By letter received January 7, 2010, Quincy Telephone Company d/b/a TDS Telecom/Quincy Telephone filed the fully executed interconnection agreement with Comcast Phone of Florida, LLC d/b/a Comcast Digital Phone, per Commission Order No. PSC-09-0839-FOF-TP. Under the requirements of 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), negotiated agreements must be submitted to the state commission for approval. Section 252(e)(4) requires the state to reject or approve the agreement within 90 days after submission or it shall be deemed approved. The statutory deadline for the Commission to take action on this matter was April 7, 2010.

Staff reviewed the agreement in this Docket on April 1, 2010. The agreement met the criteria outlined in Section 2.07.C.5.d of the Administrative Procedures Manual.
