#### **OBJECTION TO APPLICATION**

Petitioner, UPSON DOWNS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP ("Upson Downs"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, and pursuant to Rule 28-106.201, Florida Administrative Code, files this Objection to the Application of BLACK BEAR RESERVE WATER COMPANY, INC. ("Black Bear"), for a certificate to operate a water utility in Lake County, Florida to the extent such application purports to include the provision of non-potable water from the existing irrigation system, and in support thereof states:

1. The name and address of Petitioner is:

- 3. Petitioner received a copy of the Legal Notice dated June 18, 2010 from another customer. Although Petitioner is a customer of Applicant it did not receive a Legal Notice directly.
- 4. The disputed issue of material fact is Applicant's alleged ownership of the water distribution system which provides non-potable water to customers for irrigation

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purposes. Such system is owned by Petitioner. Further, Applicant's technical ability to operate a potable water system is in serious question.

5. Applicant has through the use of threats denied Petitioner the ability to operate the non-potable irrigation system. As an accommodation to the Commission Staff, Petitioner agreed not to bill customers for non-potable irrigation water service during the pending of the dispute over ownership and Applicant agreed not to disconnect customers who paid Petitioner directly for non-potable irrigation water service. Petitioner understands that notwithstanding this agreement, Applicant is disconnecting non-potable irrigation water customers. Further, Applicant does not have the technical competency to operate a water system of any kind.

6. Petitioner is entitled to relief pursuant to Section 367.045, Florida Statutes.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner, UPSON DOWNS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, requests this Commission deny Applicants' application to the extent it purports to authorize Applicant to provide non-potable irrigation water service.
