CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Item Number 9.

MS. OLLILA: Good morning, Commissioners. Sue Ollila for Commission Staff.

Item Number 9 is Gulf Power's request to initiate depreciation of its Perdido Landfill Gas to Energy Facility.

Staff recommends approval of a 5 percent depreciation rate, and Staff also recommends that the depreciation rate be implemented effective with the in-service date of the facility. Staff is available for any questions you may have.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commission board?

Commissioner Skop.

commissioner skop: Thank you. Just a
question to Staff. I guess Ms. --

MS. OLLILA: Ollila.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Ollila. Okay. I don't have the contacts in this morning, so I'm trying to discern the nametag.

On page 3 of the Staff recommendation it talks about the appropriate date or implementation date for the depreciation rate. And I think the actual in-service date as listed on page 3 of the Staff

recommendation for Issue 2 indicates that the facility's actual in-service date of commercial operation was October 7, 2010; is that correct?

MS. OLLILA: That's correct.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. And if I understand it correctly, Gulf proposed a depreciation implementation date of October 1st; is that correct?

MS. OLLILA: Yes, it did. But if I may explain.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: You may.

MS. OLLILA: That was when Gulf expected the facility to go into service at the end of September.

COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. All right. Not a problem. And based on staff's review and the actual in-service date, Staff, consistent with past Commission precedent, adopted the in-service date of October 7th as the implementation date for the depreciation rate.

MS. OLLILA: That, that's correct.

just as an accounting question, because I was scratching my head on this one, is when they do that and it's not at a, you know, clear cutoff point, for instance, the beginning of the month, the end of the month or at the beginning, middle of the month, how does the accounting work in terms of the half month or partial month

depreciation convention? 1 2 MS. OLLILA: Well, not, not being an accountant, but my guess would be that it would be 3 prorated. 4 5 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Okay. Is there anyone from ERC that -- that one befuddled me a little bit, so 6 I just thought I'd ask that question. 7 MS. OLLILA: Gulf Power representative Mr. 8 Russell Badders is here. 9 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Thank you, Mr. Badders. 10 11 MR. BADDERS: Good morning, Commissioners. 12 It's my understanding that you would use the end of the 13 month balance when you figure. So, I mean, you'd go to the end of the month. It wouldn't really matter when 14 15 you started the rates. I mean, it would just apply the 16 new rate to that balance. 17 COMMISSIONER SKOP: All right. Very well. And as a follow-up question with respect to the 20-year 18 19 average service life, that was based on the gas sales 20 contract; is that correct? 21 MR. BADDERS: That is correct. 22 COMMISSIONER SKOP: If the term of that 23 underlying agreement is extended, will that affect the

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depreciation rate?

MR. BADDERS: I believe it would, but that

would be calculated at a later point. 1 COMMISSIONER SKOP: And either Staff or Gulf 2 would come back to the Commission and work out those 3 4 numbers. MR. BADDERS: That's correct. 5 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Very well. Thank you. 6 7 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Any further questions from the Commission? Seeing none, I call for a motion. 8 COMMISSIONER BRISÉ: Sure. Move Staff. 9 COMMISSIONER SKOP: Second. 10 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It's been moved and seconded 11 to move Staff recommendation on Issue Number 9 -- I'm 12 sorry, Item Number 9. Any further discussion?
