NOTICE OF PROPOSED AGENCY ACTION  
ORDER CANCELLING COMPETITIVE LOCAL EXCHANGE  
TELECOMMUNICATIONS CERTIFICATES

BY THE COMMISSION:

NOTICE is hereby given by the Florida Public Service Commission that the action discussed herein is preliminary in nature and will become final unless a person whose interests are substantially affected files a petition for a formal proceeding, pursuant to Rule 25-22.029, Florida Administrative Code.

Comtel Telcom Assets LP d/b/a VarTec Telecom d/b/a VarTec Solutions d/b/a Excel Telecommunications (Comtel) holder of Competitive Local Exchange Telecommunications Certificates (CLEC) of Public Convenience and Necessity Nos. 5687, 4699, and 4695 have requested the cancellation of CLEC Certificates Nos. 5687, 4699, and 4695.

Comtel has complied with the provision of Rule 25-24.820(2), Florida Administrative Code, by providing adequate notice in writing of its request for cancellation of its CLEC certificate and by submitting its Regulatory Assessment Fees (RAFs) for the year 2010. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to cancel CLEC Certificates Nos. 5687, 4699, and 4695 effective August 2, 2010. We are vested with jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Section 364.335, Florida Statutes.
