AT&T FLORIDA'S REQUEST FOR SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Florida ("AT&T Florida"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files its Request for Specified Confidential Classification.

- 1. On December 2, 2010, AT&T Florida filed a Memorandum of Understanding between American Dial Tone, Inc. f/k/a Ganoco, Inc. ("ADT") and AT&T Florida in the captioned docket, along with a Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification.
- 2. AT&T Florida hereby files this Request for Specified Confidential Classification because the information contained in Exhibit A of the Memorandum of Understanding contains information that is confidential business information to ADT. A more specific description of this information is contained in Attachment A.
- 3. The information discussed in the Request for Specified Confidential
 Classification is valuable to ADT and it strives to keep the information secret. Therefore, such information should be classified as confidential business information pursuant to Section
 364.183, Florida Statutes. Accordingly, it should be held exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

- 4. Attachment A to AT&T's Request for Confidential Classification contains an explanation of the proprietary information along with a list that identifies the location of the information designated as confidential.
- 5. Attachment B to AT&T's Request for Confidential Classification is two redacted copies of the documents.
- 6. Attachment C to AT&T's Request for Confidential Classification is a highlighted copy of the document containing the confidential information.
- 7. The information discussed in this Request for Specified Confidential Classification is valuable to ADT, and it treats this information as confidential and this information has not been generally disclosed.
- 8. The original of this Request was filed today with the Office of the Commission Clerk and a copy was served on the Parties.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, AT&T Florida respectfully requests that, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, the Commission enter an order declaring the information described above to be confidential, proprietary business information that is not subject to public disclosure.
