By this letter, the Commission staff requests that Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC or utility) provide responses to the following data requests.

- Please refer to the table completed in response to Question No. 4 of Staff's First Data 1 Request. How does the total cost figure of \$16,573 compare with FPUC's total ECCR expenditures?
- In the response to Question No. 5 of Staff's First Data Request, FPUC states that purchased power costs were higher than they would have been if FPUC had met the goals and that if FPUC had met the goals, the lower purchase power costs would not be sufficient to offset the program costs which would have resulted in increased cost to the ratepayers. Please expand upon your answer and provide cost projections/estimates to support your assertions.
- 3. In the response to Question No. 5 of Staff's First Data Request, FPUC states that the reduced greenhouse gas emissions due to reduced power generation to supply purchased power would be offset by increased emissions to implement additional participation in programs. For clarification, please provide an example of how emissions would be increased to implement additional participation.
