PETITION FOR EXPEDITED REVIEW OF GROWTH CODE DENIAL

Sprint Communications Company, L.P. ("Sprint"), pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.15(g)(iv), Federal Communications Commission Order FCC 00-104 ("*FCC Order 00-104*"), and Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, petitions the Commission to review the Pooling Administrator's ("Neustar's) denial of Sprint's request for additional numbering resources in the Coral Springs Rate Center. In support of this petition, Sprint states:

PARTIES

1. Sprint is a competitive local exchange company authorized to provide local exchange telecommunications in the State of Florida.

2. Neustar is an independent non-governmental entity, which is responsible for administering and managing the numbering resources in pooling areas. *See* 47 C.F.R § 52.20(d).

JURISDICTION

3. This Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to the Industry Numbering Committee's (INC) Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c). These sections provide that a carrier may challenge Neustar's decision to deny numbering resources to the appropriate regulatory authority which is, in this case, the Commission.

BACKGROUND AND REQUEST FOR RELIEF

On August 17, 2011, Sprint requested additional numbering resources from 4. Neustar. See Attachment 1. Specifically, Sprint requested one (1) thousand-block in the 954 NPA in the rate center of Coral Springs. At the time of the code request, Sprint had a utilization threshold of 64% and Months to Exhaust ("MTE") of 13.8 in the Coral Springs Rate Center.

5. On August 17, 2011, Neustar's automated number request system denied Sprint's request for additional numbering resources because Sprint had not met the utilization based criteria, notwithstanding the fact that Sprint is unable to provide the numbering resources requested by the specific customer. See Confidential Attachment 1. Pursuant to the requirements of Commission Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, attached to this Petition is the MTE and utilization rate for Sprint's switch in the Coral Springs Rate Center. See Confidential Attachment 2.

6. Also provided to meet the Commission's requirements set forth in Commission Order No. PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL, please find in Confidential Attachment 3 the written request from Sprint's customer for these numbering resources and, therein, the customer's contact information.

7. As discussed above, both the FCC Order and the INC guidelines provide that state. regulatory authorities have the power and authority to review Neustar's decision to deny a request for numbering resources. See INC Number Pooling Guidelines Sections 3.7 and 12(c).

8. Under existing procedures for code requests, Neustar looks only at the number of MTE and utilization for the entire rate center without exception, no other factors, which is why Sprint's request was denied. Neustar denied Sprint's request on the grounds that Sprint did not meet the 75% utilization threshold and the six (6) Months To Exhaust criteria.

9. Sprint requests that the Commission's reverse Neustar's decision to withhold numbering resources from Sprint because Neustar's denial of numbering resources to Sprint interferes with Sprint's ability to serve its customers within the State of Florida. Sprint's customer has made a reasonable request for additional numbers that Sprint cannot meet without additional numbering resources.

WHEREFORE, Sprint requests that the Commission:

1. Review the decision of Neustar to deny Sprint's request for additional numbering

resources for the Coral Springs Rate Center; and

2. Direct Neustar to provide the requested numbering resources to Sprint for the Coral Springs Rate Center as discussed above.

is currently assigned native telephone numbers in the 754 NPA for its residential and business phone service being provided in Coral Springs, Florida. The residential phone service has been offered to residents in Coral Springs since September 2008. However, we have just begun offering the business phone service in this community within the past 60 days.

In the short time that we have been offering our business phone service, we have lost the opportunity to serve two new businesses moving into our service area because they would not accept a 754 area code with the native numbers we offered them. The prevailing area code for Broward County, Florida, including Coral Springs, is 954.

These two potential new customers were concerned that a 754 area code would possibly cause a negative impact to their businesses, because callers would assume that they were not in the Broward County/Coral Springs area and that a call to them would be long distance. As a result of our not being able to provide them with a 954 area code, these businesses contracted with another phone service provider.

allocated for use and have yet to meet the needed 75% utilization to allow ordering through your normal process. Thus, we are requesting that a "safety valve" be submitted so that we can accommodate future requests from potential new customers who will only accept a native telephone number with the 954 area code.
