PETITION OF TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the company's conservation cost recovery true-up and the cost recovery factors proposed for use during the period January through December 2012. In support thereof, the company says:

Conservation Cost Recovery

1. During the period January through December 2010, Tampa Electric incurred actual net conservation costs of \$43,371,442, plus a beginning true-up under-recovery of \$1,434,024, for a total of \$44,805,466. The amount collected through the Conservation Cost Recovery Clause was \$43,755,867. The true-up amount for January through December 2010 was an under-recovery of \$1,053,754, including interest. (See Exhibit (HTB-1); Schedule CT-3, page 2 of 3).

2. During the period January through December 2011, the company anticipates incurring expenses of \$47,586,744. For the period the total net true-up over-recovery is estimated to be \$1,288,708, including interest. (See Exhibit (HTB-2); Schedule C-3, page 6 of 7).

3. For the forthcoming cost recovery period, January through December 2012, Tampa Electric projects its total incremental conservation costs to be \$53,264,836. Tampa Electric's total true-up and projected expenditures for the projection period are estimated to be \$51,976,128, including true-up estimates for January through December 2011. When the required true-up and projected expenditures are appropriately spread over the projected sales for interruptible customers and firm retail customers pursuant to Docket No. 080317-EI, Order No. PSC-09-0283-FOF4ETATE

dated April 30, 2009, the required conservation cost recovery factors for the period January through December 2012 are as follows: 0.302 cents per kWh for Residential, 0.288 cents per kWh for General Service Non-Demand and Temporary Service, 1.05 dollars per kW for Full Requirement General Service Demand - Secondary, 1.04 dollars per kW for Full Requirement General Service Demand - Primary, 1.03 dollars per kW for Full Requirement General Service Demand -Subtransmission, 1.05 dollars per kW for Standby Service - Secondary, 1.04 dollars per kW for Standby Service - Primary, 1.03 dollars per kW for Standby Service - Subtransmission, 0.92 dollars per kW for Interruptible Service - Secondary, 0.91 dollars per kW for Interruptible Service -Primary, 0.90 dollars per kW for Interruptible Service - Subtransmission, 0.250 cents per kWh for General Service Demand Optional – Secondary, 0.248 cents per kWh for General Service Demand Optional - Primary, 0.245 cents per kWh for General Service Demand Optional - Subtransmission, and 0.151 cents per kWh for Lighting. (See Exhibit (HTB-2); Schedule C-1, page 1 of 1.)

4. For the forthcoming cost recovery period, January through December 2012, the Contracted Credit Value for the GSLM-2 and GSLM-3 rate riders will be \$9.82 per kW. (See Exhibit (HTB-2); page 63.)

5. For the forthcoming cost recovery period, January through December 2012, the residential Price Responsive Load Management ("RSVP-1) rates are as follows:
