2. <u>Date of Planned Service Discontinuance</u>: Applicant plans to discontinue calling-card services on or around December 31, 2011, or as soon thereafter as any necessary regulatory approvals are obtained. Applicant understands that this application will be **a**utomatically granted on the 31st day after public notice of filing unless the Commission notifies Applicant to the contrary. See 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(c).

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3. <u>Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected</u>: Applicant proposes to discontinue calling-card services throughout the United States.

4. <u>Description of Service Affected</u>: The affected services are long-distance calling-card telephone services, which enable customers to make long-distance calls by dialing a toll-free number, then entering a personal identification number and then entering the number to be called.

5. <u>Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected</u>

<u>Customers</u>: Applicant has sent a written notification of the planned discontinuance to affected customers in accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules.

6. <u>Whether the Carrier is Considered Dominant or Non-dominant with</u> <u>Respect to the Service to be Discontinued</u>: Applicant is considered non-dominant with respect to the services to be discontinued.
