BIRCH COMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF AUDIT WORKPAPERS

Birch Communications, Inc. ("Birch" or "Company") by and through its undersigned counsel, pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006(4), Florida Administrative Code, hereby submits its Request for Confidential Classification for information contained in the Staff Audit Workpapers (ACN 11-160-4-4 and ACN 11-160-4-3) associated with a regulatory assessment fee audit conducted by the staff. In support thereof, Birch hereby states that:

1. Certain specified information included in the Staff's Audit Workpapers includes financial information and corporate strategic information that has not otherwise been publicly disclosed. If disclosed, particularly out of context, this information could both harm the Company's ability to continue to obtain financing on favorable terms and impair the Company's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms, which would ultimately have detrimental impacts on the Company and its Company's business operations.

2. The information for which Birch seeks confidential classification is information that the Company treats as confidential, and that meets the definition of "proprietary confidential business information" as set forth in Section 364.183(3), Florida Statutes, which provides:

(3) The term "proprietary confidential business information" means information, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm

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to the ratepayers or the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public. The term includes, but is not limited to:

(a) Trade secrets.

(b) Internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors.

(c) Security measures, systems, or procedures.

(d) Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the company or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms.

(e) Information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

(f) Employee personnel information unrelated to compensation, duties, qualifications, or responsibilities.

3. Attached as Exhibit A to this Request is a matrix identifying the specific portions of the Audit Workpapers for which the Company is seeking confidential treatment, along with the specific justification for each item specified in this request. Birch has also included as Exhibit B, a separate envelope labeled "Confidential" which contains one highlighted copy of the Audit Workpapers. Also, included with this filing are two redacted copies of the information, as Exhibit C.

4. Birch asks that confidential classification be granted for a period of at least 18 months. Should the Commission no longer find that it needs to retain the information, Birch respectfully requests that the confidential information be returned to the Company.

5. Exhibit B to this Request is one highlighted copy of the referenced Staff Audit Workpapers, contained in a separate envelope marked "Confidential." Exhibit C to this Request is two redacted copies of the referenced Staff Audit Workpapers.

WHEREFORE, Birch respectfully requests that the highlighted information contained in Staff's Audit Workpapers associated with Audit Control Nos. 11-160-4-4 and 11-160-4-3 be

classified as "proprietary confidential business information," and thus, exempt from Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.
