CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Item Number 5. Staff, please.

MS. WU: Good afternoon, Mr. Chairman,
Commissioners, Item 5 is staff's recommendation on the
contested issue during the ECRC hearing. The issue was
raised by Florida Power Users Group to address whether
Progress Energy Florida, Inc. should be permitted to
recover any environmental costs related to its purchases
of replacement power due to the CR-3 extended outage.

The evidence in the record shows that PEF did not incur any environmental cost, specifically the purchase of emission allowance associated with its purchase of replacement power due to the CR-3 outage. Therefore, no costs to recover.

Staff recommends that the amount shown on Table 1 at Page 4 of staff's recommendation should be included in PEF's 2012 ECRC factors.

Staff is available for any questions you may have.

CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: Commissioner Balbis.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

I have one clarification that I'd like staff to make.

You stated in the recommendation that there are no costs to recover, and yet you are asking -- you

are recommending that listing the cost in Table 1 of costs that they incurred. I assume those are costs that they incurred due to self-generation, is that correct?

MS. WU: That's correct.

commissioner Balbis: Okay. I just wanted to point that out, because it was a little confusing when you're saying they didn't incur costs and yet here are the costs you have to approve. So I just wanted to point that out.

MS. WU: Just for clarification, no costs incurred associated with the issue as it is framed, but there were costs incurred associated with self-generating replacement power.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay, thank you.

And I guess going back to the argument and decision that we just made concerning costs associated with the CR-3 outage, I would maintain the same argument applies from the 01 docket to the 07 docket concerning that, and the only difference being the accounting methodology for the credits that's listed, the average cost versus the first-in/first-out method of accounting. And I think that if we changed the methodology at this point, obviously, those costs will have to be passed on to the other -- the other portions of the credits that were given, so it would increase their costs to make

these zero costs. And I'm not comfortable with changing horses mid-race, so I would support staff's 2 recommendation on these issues. 3 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: So your motion is you want to support recommendation on the entirety of Item Number 5 4 -- I'm sorry, Item Number 5? COMMISSIONER BALBIS: That is correct. 7 CHAIRMAN GRAHAM: It has been moved and 8 seconded, staff recommendation on Item Number 5.
