  - a. where can those specific provisions be found?



b. has QCC filed a billing dispute with your company regarding the rate it pays for switched access service under the provisions outlined in your price list? When was the dispute filed and has it been resolved?

Qwest submitted a dispute with Access Integrated Networks, Inc. ("AIN," now known as Birch Communications, Inc.) in February 2008 for intrastate switched access charges which included usage originating and terminating within Florida. That dispute was based on certain terms in the AIN-QCC wholesale services agreement ("WSA"), which Qwest claims is confidential.

Qwest's stated basis for the dispute is contained in the attached February 2008 letter, marked as CONFIDENTIAL Appendix Staff INT 7 (Bates stamped pages BCI/AIN 00071 to BCI/AIN 00073.)



After that dispute was resolved, Qwest has only filed disputes for Interstate usage billed for the nine Southeastern states including Florida. Starting in October 2008 and continuing each month thereafter, Qwest has submitted disputes for Interstate Switched Access Charges that include minutes of use originating with or terminating to end users in Florida. These disputes remain open.
