Request for Confidential Classification for MFR Schedule D-2

On March 19, 2012, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL or Utility) filed its request for confidential classification for MFR Schedule D-2. The document includes information related to the capital structure of FPL's affiliated and consolidated companies. FPL claims the information is intended to be and is treated as private and confidential and has not been disclosed externally. Staff has reviewed the documents and concurs with FPL that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm FPL's competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends that FPL's request for confidential classification of MFR Schedule D-2 be approved.
