Dear Ms. Cole:
I would like to submit a correction to the sanitary survey on the Dockel No. 100048-WU for Winding Waters Sulbdivision. The Sanitary survey that was submitted shows two pumps for a total of 811 gallons per minute, which is incorrect. The sanitary survey also shows a 40 HP pump as one of the pumps and the other pump is unknown, which is also incorrect.

The pump station has a 20 HP pump with a total head of 185 feet that produces 160 gallons per minute. The Station also has a 30 HP pump with a total head of 120 feet that produces 600 gallons per minute.

The two pumps total 760 gallons per minute of pumping capacity. I will contact the Florida Department of Envirommental Protection to clarify these mistakes.

Winding Waters also showed a maximum day pumping of 118,000 on January 19, 2010 according to the Monthly Operating Reports, this high use was caused by a main line leak that occurred on that day. The second highest use in 2010 was 99,000 gallons on May 18,2010 , which was caused by a service line leak. The grealest amount pumped without any explanation was 95,000 on January $14,2010$.
