Pursuant to Order No. PSC-12-0260-PAA-WU, issued May 29, 2012, the docket was to remain open pending submission of closing documents, a recorded warranty deed, and updated general ledger balances, at which time the docket should be closed administratively.

On May 15, 2012, in D.N. 00377-12, Raintree Harbor Utilities, LLC filed a recorded warranty deed reflecting the transfer of the land under Raintree Harbor water system plant from Raintree Utilities, Inc. to itself. On May 22, 2012, in D.N. 03249-12, Raintree Utilities, Inc. filed a recorded warranty deed reflecting the transfer of the Bentwood water system to the Bentwood Homeowners Association, Inc. On June 22, 2012, in D.N. 04147-!2, Raintree Harbor Utilities, LLC filed revised general ledger balances which showed the Utility's books have been updated to reflect the Commission-approved account balances as of December 31, 2011, along with a statement that these numbers will be reflected in the Utility's 2012 Annual Report.

Therefore, staff recommends that all requirements of Order No. PSC-12-0260-PAA-WU have been met and the docket/may be administratively closed.
