We are in receipt of your July 10, 2012 letter requesting the Public Service Commission to set emergency rates for Harbor Hills Utility, LP (Harbor Hills) pending the approval of your application to certificate the utilities.

As you are aware, your application for original certificates for existing water and waste water systems are pending and are expected to come to Agenda sometime in the next several months.
