RE: Docket No. 120313-GU - Petition for approval of transportation service agreement with Florida Public Utilities Company, by Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc.

On December 20, 2012, Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. (Peninsula) filed a Request for Confidential Classification (Request) for information contained in Attachment A (DN 08274-12; x-ref. DN 08150-12) of its Transportation Service Agreement with Florida Public Utilities Company (FPUC). The Request states that both Peninsula and FPUC treat this information as proprietary confidential business information consistent with the definition of that term in Section 366.093(3), Florida Statutes.

After reviewing the above referenced document, staff agrees that disclosure of the redacted information could harm both Peninsula and FPUC's business operations and ratepayers by impairing the Companies' respective abilities to effectively negotiate for goods and services; therefore, staff recommends the request be granted.
