Order No. PSC-08-0417-PAA-TP, issued in this docket, was protested by 3 of the 20 Eligible Telecommunications Companies (ETCs) involved: Verizon Florida, LLC (wire line), Sprint/Nextel (wireless), and Verizon Wireless (f/k/a Alltel Communications, LLC.) Through issuance of Order No. PSC-09-0782-AS-TP, the Commission approved a post hearing settlement agreement resolving the issues for Verizon Florida, LLC. The remaining two parties of record that protested the order, Sprint Nextel and Verizon Wireless, both relinquished their ETC designations in Florida through filings with the Federal Communications Commission; therefore, the issues in this docket no longer apply to them. APM 2.07 authorizes Staff to dispose of certain matters administratively. Specifically, APM 2.07 C.2.d.(4) states:

Other dockets initiated by the filing of a petition, application, notice, complaint or other request in which the applicant, petitioner or complainant seeks to withdraw its initial pleading and staff has determined that there are no pending issues that need to be addressed by the Commission regarding the filing, and no request for refund of filing fee has been made.
