sodium lights to LED light fixtures. And I was surprised at the time that Florida Power and Light did not offer an LED tariff. And then I believe it was January of 2011, Progress Energy moved forward with an LED tariff, and I made some comments at that time, you know, thanking Progress for doing so and making LED lights available for customers so they can realize the energy savings that technology provides. So I want to thank TECO for moving forward in a similar fashion.

And the question I have for staff, of the investor-owned utilities that we do fully regulate, how many of them do offer an LED tariff?

MS. DRAPER: In addition to Progress, Gulf Power also offers an LED tariff. And I contacted FPL, and they are still in the process of evaluating and doing a pilot study on LED tariffs, and may be forthcoming with a tariff, too.

Thank you. Again, I'm surprised. I'm glad to hear that, perhaps, all of the utilities are going to move forward with this tariff again so that customers can realize these savings.
