Progress Energy Florida ("PEF" or the "Company"), pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, files this Second Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of the confidential portions of the documents and information produced in response to the Office of Public Counsel's First Request for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-4). Portions of the documents and information contained in these responses contain proprietary and confidential business information which the Company does not disclose to the public, including contractual data the disclosure of which would impair PEF's ability to contract for necessary goods and services and in many cases would violate contractual confidentiality clauses, internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors, and other information the disclosure of which would harm the Company's competitive business interests.


