In the enclosed document you will find NHC Utilities, Inc.'s Application Form for Grandfather Certificate (Section 367.171). Per your request, I have included additional information about the company in this letter below.

Of note in the enclosed application is the absence of information regarding wastewater treatment as the property does not treat waste on its premises. Additionally, in its capacity as a water utility, NHC merely purchases water from the city to be distributed to each of its residents.

Prior to the transfer of jurisdiction to the Public Service Commission, NHC had no water quality issues to report or any customer service issues. The entire property is on the mainland and though no wastewater treatment plant resides on the premises, waste is piped to Riverwood CDD's wastewater processing plant.

#### **NOTICE TO CUSTOMERS**

Pursuant to Section 367.081(4)(a), Florida Statutes, water and wastewater utilities are permitted to adjust the rates and charges to their customers without those customers bearing the additional expense of a public hearing. These adjustments in rates would depend on increases or decreases in noncontrollable expenses subject to inflationary pressures such as chemicals and other general operation and maintenances costs.

On August 23, 2005, NHC Utilities, Inc., filed its notice of intention with the Florida Public Service Commission to increase water rates in Charlotte County pursuant to this Statute. The filing is subject to review by the Commission Staff for accuracy and completeness. Water rates will increase by approximately 0.86%. These rates should be reflected for service rendered on or after October 22, 2005.
