The above-referenced application has been received and reviewed by my staff. In order to ensure fast, expedient treatment of your rate case, please have the following information submitted to the Commission on or before July 5, 2013.

1. A copy of all Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Permits.
2. A copy of all Discharge Monitoring Reports filed with the DEP for the period beginning in January 2012 through June 2013.
3. A copy of Monthly Operating Reports filed with the DEP for the period beginning in January 2012 through June 2013.
4. A copy of all wastewater treatment plant flow measuring device calibration reports for the past three years.
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6. A copy of all correspondence, inspection reports, notices of violation, or consent orders from DEP in the past three years.
  
7. A schedule showing the amount of water sold each month from January 2012 through June 2013.
  
8. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.130, F.A.C., each utility shall maintain a record of written complaints received by the utility from any of the utility's customers. Please provide a list of complaints received by the utility from any of the utility's customers during the past three years and an explanation of how each was resolved.
  
9. A description of all assets (land, treatment facilities, pumps, storage tanks, water distribution system, collection systems, and lift stations) owned by the utility.
  
10. A description of any planned or future expansion of your service area.
  
11. A description of any plant additions or repairs that have been made in the past year along with the cost and reason for the addition or repair. If the additions or repairs are in response to a DEP or health department compliance requirement, provide a copy of the supporting documentation.
  
12. A description of any plant additions or repairs that are expected to be made in the next year, along with the estimated cost and reason for the addition or repair. The cost should include at least two bids to support the addition or repair. If the additions or repairs are in response to a DEP or health department compliance requirement, provide a copy of the supporting documentation.
  
13. A list of all general service customers and their type of businesses.
  
14. Please verify that the engineering data provided in III, G.12 of the SARC application is correctly stated as 0.384 MG treated in the most recent 12 months.
