In march of this year HC Waterworks Inc bought out our water system from Aqua utilitys. Starting in the month of April HC Waterworks over billed every resident in the Covered Bridge Community. When I contacted them regarding this I was told that they used the information that Aqua gave them concerning the basic rates and per gallon charge.
