**FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR
CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN INFORMATION
CONTAINED IN EXHIBIT GJY-3 TO THE FUEL HEDGING ACTIVITY REPORT**

Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C., and Section 366.093, Florida Statutes, requests confidential classification of certain information on fuel hedging activities and market comparisons contained in FPL's Fuel Hedging Activity Report. In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

1. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-08-0316-PAA-EI, FPL filed its Fuel Hedging Activity Report on August 16, 2013, which will be adopted as exhibit GJY-3 in the testimony of FPL witness Gerry J. Yupp in FPL's August 30, 2013 filing in this docket. FPL's Fuel Hedging Activity Report contains FPL proprietary confidential business information. This request is intended to request confidential classification of information contained in the Fuel Hedging Activity Report.

2. The following exhibits are included with this Request:

a. Exhibit A consists of a copy of the Fuel Hedging Activity Report, in which the confidential information has been highlighted.

b. Exhibit B consists of a copy of the Fuel Hedging Activity Report in which the confidential information has been redacted.

c. Exhibit C is a table containing an identification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A, together with references to the specific statutory bases for the claim of confidentiality and to the affiant who supports the requested confidential classification.

d. Exhibit D consists of the affidavit of Gerard J. Yupp, Senior Director of Wholesale Operations for FPL's Energy Marketing and Trading Division in support of this Request for Confidential Classification.

3. FPL submits that the highlighted information in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S. This information is intended to be and is treated by FPL as private, and its confidentiality has been maintained. Pursuant to Section 366.093, F.S., such information is entitled to confidential treatment and it is exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

4. As the affidavit included as Exhibit D indicates, FPL's Fuel Hedging Activity Report contains or constitutes data pertinent to FPL's fuel hedging program, specifically, the physical and financial details related to FPL's year-to-date hedging results for natural gas and fuel oil. This information constitutes trade secrets of FPL, and is protected by Section 366.093(3)(a), F.S. Additionally, this information, if disclosed would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods and services on favorable terms for the benefit of its customers, would impair the competitive interests of FPL and its vendors, and would place FPL at a competitive disadvantage when coupled with other information that is publicly available. This information is protected by Sections 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S.

5. Upon a finding by the Commission that the Fuel Hedging Activity Report in Exhibit A is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093(3), F.S., pursuant to Section 366.093(4), F.S. such materials should not be declassified for at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information no longer is necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.

WHEREFORE, FPL respectfully requests confidential classification of the Fuel Hedging Activity Report.


BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Gerard J. Yupp who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:
