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## PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Moving on to Item Number 5.

MR. GARL: Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

Item 5 is a petition from Florida City Gas requesting approval of tariff modifications for natural gas vehicles. The company proposes three methods of providing fueling of NGVs. In the first method, City Gas would provide fueling facilities on the customers' premises. Second would be limited access facilities on City Gas property. And the third method would be publicly accessible fueling facilities on City Gas premises.

Staff analysis has shown the proposal is reasonable, cost-based, and will allow City Gas to recover its costs of providing NGV service.

Staff recommends approval.

CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: All right. Thank you very much.

Commissioners, any -- okay, Commissioner Balbis.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Thank you. I have a quick question for the company.

Of those three options, which one do you think would be more attractive or most attractive to

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customers? Do you have any feeling about that, or are you just going to propose these three options and see what the market dictates?

MR. SULMONETTI: This is Brian Sulmonetti with Florida City Gas. We are not exactly sure, but probably the first option, you know, people wanting to put compressors and so forth on their property in the beginning. And hopefully we can get to limited access. You know, it's kind of a train of events there.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Okay. Thank you.

And I would make similar comments,

thanking the company for moving forward with these
changes, and hopefully it will encourage companies
to make the switch, so --

CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: All right. Thank you very much. Any further comments or questions?

Okay. Seeing none, I think now it's appropriate for a motion.

COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Mr. Chairman, I move approval of staff's recommendation on all issues.
