Additionally, Quest has requested oral argument. Staff recommends denying the request.

However, should the Commission in its discretion grant oral argument, staff recommends that each party be allowed five minutes.

argument, should it be granted. Staff is available for 1 2 any questions. CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Thank you very much. 3 Commissioner Edgar. 4 5 COMMISSIONER EDGAR: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I was Prehearing Officer on this -- I guess I 6 7 still am --CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Yes. 8 9 **COMMISSIONER EDGAR:** -- on this docket, and I 10 will say that it is one of those that stretched over a longer period of time. So perhaps, I don't remember 11 for sure, but it might have been Chairman Graham who 12 13 assigned the panel. 14 (Laughter.) COMMISSIONER EDGAR: With that, then, Mr. 16 17 Chairman, I would move staff recommendation on all issues in this item. 18 19 CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Okay. COMMISSIONER BALBIS: Second. 2.0 CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: Okay. It has been moved and 21 22 seconded. Any further discussion? Seeing none, all in favor. 23 24 (Vote taken.) 25 CHAIRMAN BRISÉ: All right.
