Request for Confidential Classification for Docket No. 04524-13

On August 5, 2013, Consolidated Services of Hendry & Collier, LP (Consolidated Services or Utility) filed its supplement to requests for confidential classification for Document No. 04524-13. The document is part of Consolidated Services' response to a staff deficiency letter, dated June 6, 2013. Certain information produced in response to staff's deficiency letter consists of financial information related to Consolidated Services' privately-held parent, Consolidated Citrus Limited Partnership. The Utility claims the information is intended to be, and is treated by Consolidated Services and its parent as private and confidential, has not been disclosed externally, and has been strictly controlled internally. Staff has reviewed the document and concurs with the Utility that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business interests, operations, and private negotiations of Consolidated Services' parent. Therefore, staff recommends that Consolidated Services' request for confidential classification of Document No. 04524-13 be approved.
