## <u>ISSUE 4</u>: What should be the effective date of the new conservation cost recovery factors for billing purposes?

**FPL:** The factors should be effective beginning with the specified conservation cost recovery cycle and thereafter for the period January 2014 through December 2014. Billing cycles may start before January 1, 2014 and the last cycle may be read after December 31, 2014, so that each customer is billed for twelve months regardless of when the adjustment factor became effective. These charges should continue in effect until modified by subsequent order of this Commission. (Keith)
