Florida City Gas: An over-recovery of \$1,408,722.

What are the actual/estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up

amounts for the period January 2013 through December 2013?

Florida City Gas: An under-recovery of \$1,312,868.

Issue 3:

What are the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amounts to be

collected during the period January 2014 through December 2014?

Florida City Gas: An over-recovery of \$95,854, for a true-up refund factor of 00.225

cents per therm.

Issue 4:

What are the levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factors for
